Punctuality Research:

Being late or Being picked up early reduces learning time.

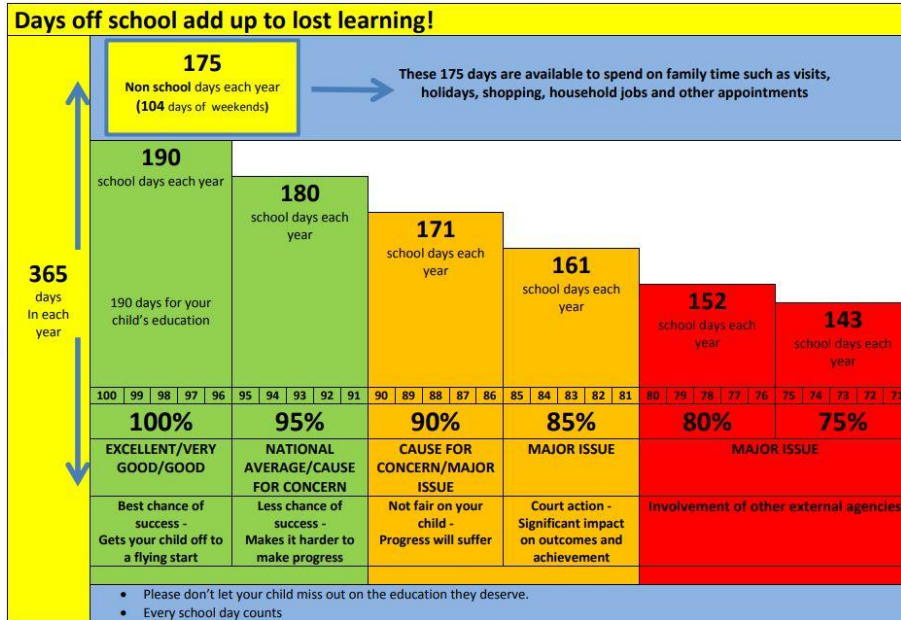
