Curriculum

- Intrepid explorers

- How do our toys and games compare with those of children in the 1960s?

Reading

Reading opens up the whole curriculum.

- Develops fluency
- Develops understanding of vocabulary
- Develops reading comprehension
- Gives a wealth of knowledge.

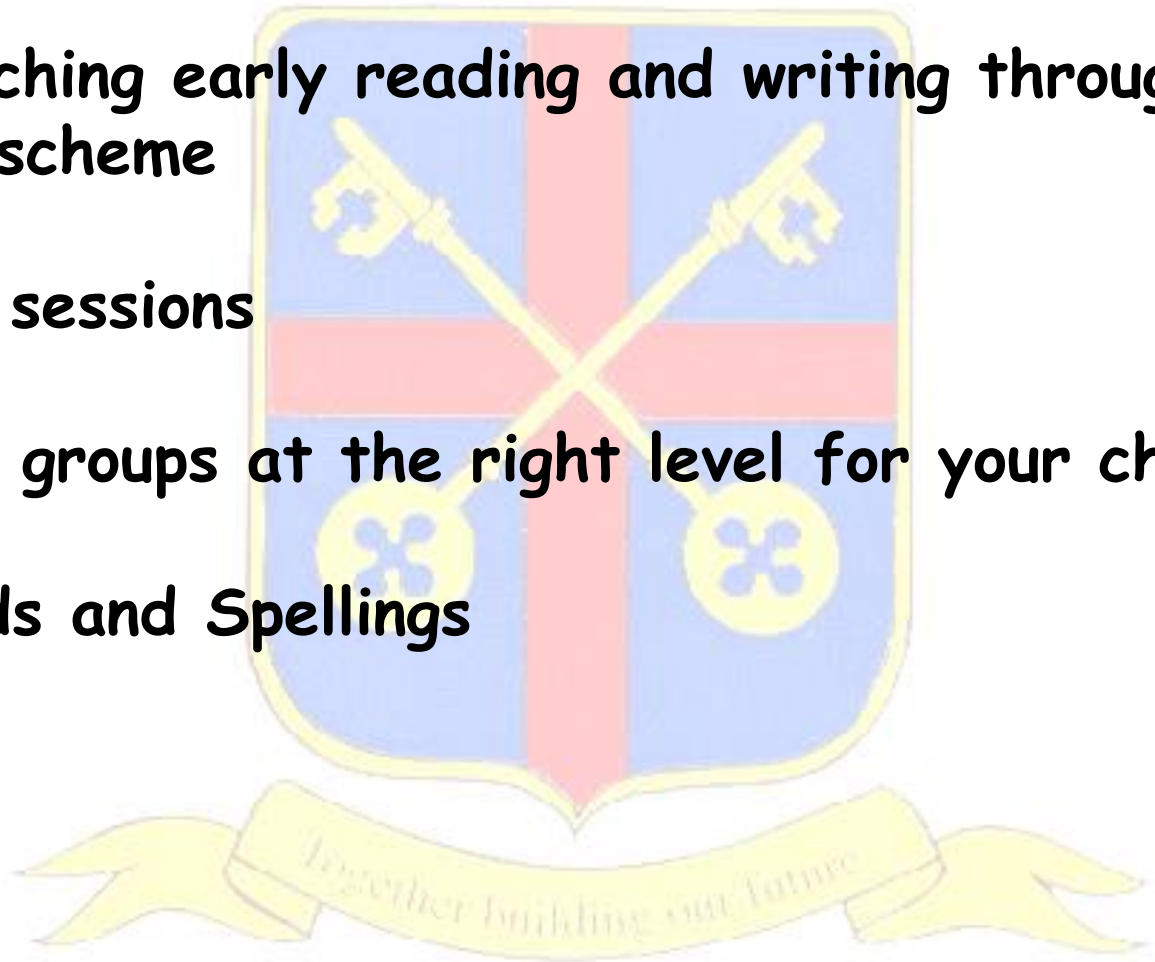
Please read regularly with your child, at least 4 times a week, and make a record of this in the reading record.



RWInc

We teaching early reading and writing through the RWInc scheme

- **Daily sessions**
- **Small groups at the right level for your child**
- **Sounds and Spellings**



Accelerated Reader

- Ensures children are reading a book at the correct level.
- Children quiz on completed books to check understanding.
- Children build up their word count.
- Reading records checked every Monday.
- Opportunity to read home reader in school as well as at home.
- Information sent home at regular intervals to inform you how your child is progressing in comparison to year group.
- We also read guided class texts and we read regularly in other areas of the curriculum.

Writing

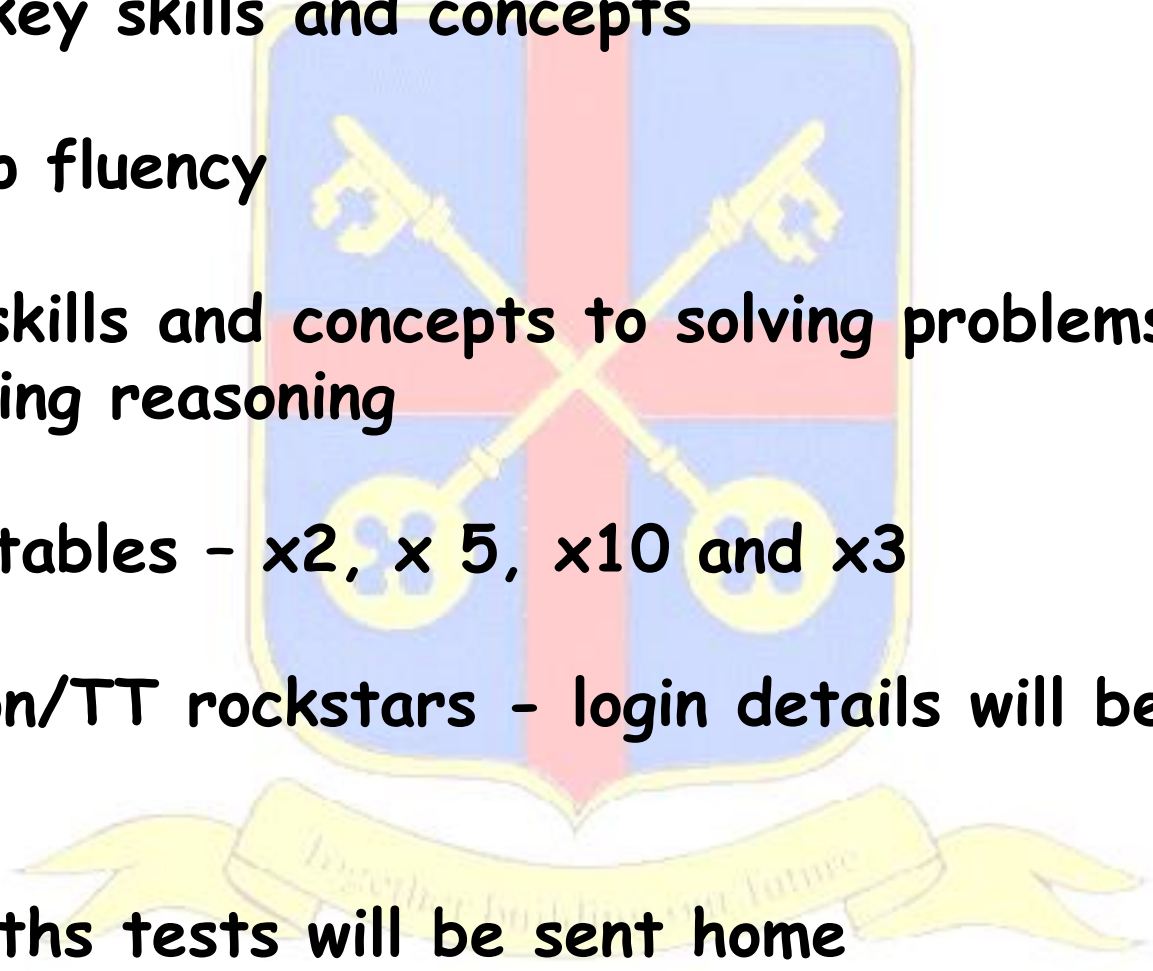
We write every day in English lessons and in topic work:

- Different genres
- Grammar
- Spelling session
- Handwriting - correct formation, size, positioning and joining



Maths

- Learn key skills and concepts
- Develop fluency
- Apply skills and concepts to solving problems and explaining reasoning
- Times tables - $\times 2$, $\times 5$, $\times 10$ and $\times 3$
- Numicon/TT rockstars - login details will be sent home
- Big Maths tests will be sent home



Assessment

Children will be assessed against the terms:

- WB - **Working Below** age related expectations
- WT - **Working Towards** age related expectations
- WA - **Working At** age related expectations
- GD - Working at **Greater Depth**

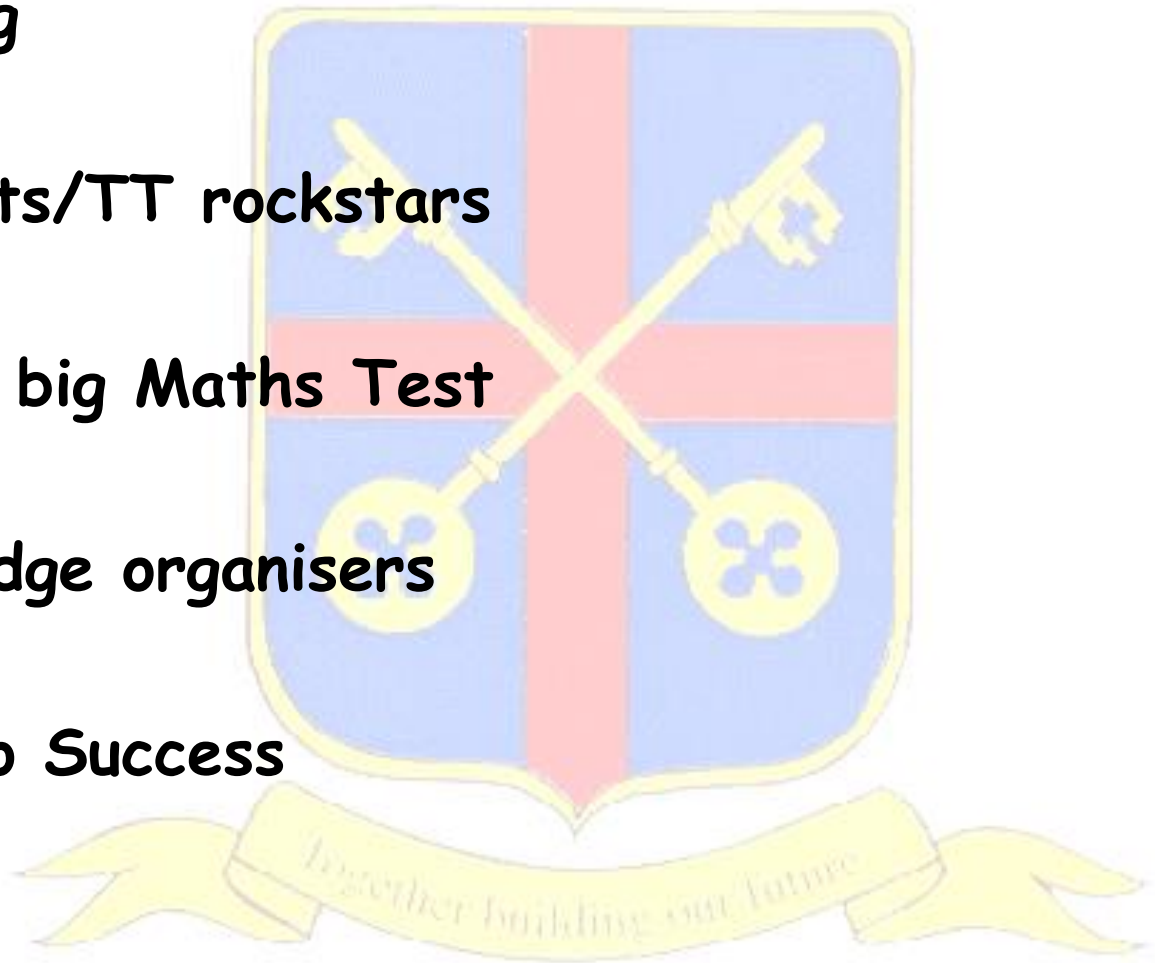
Assessments usually take place four times a year, to track progress.

- Y2 SAT's - not compulsory but will be administered at the end of term to support teacher assessments

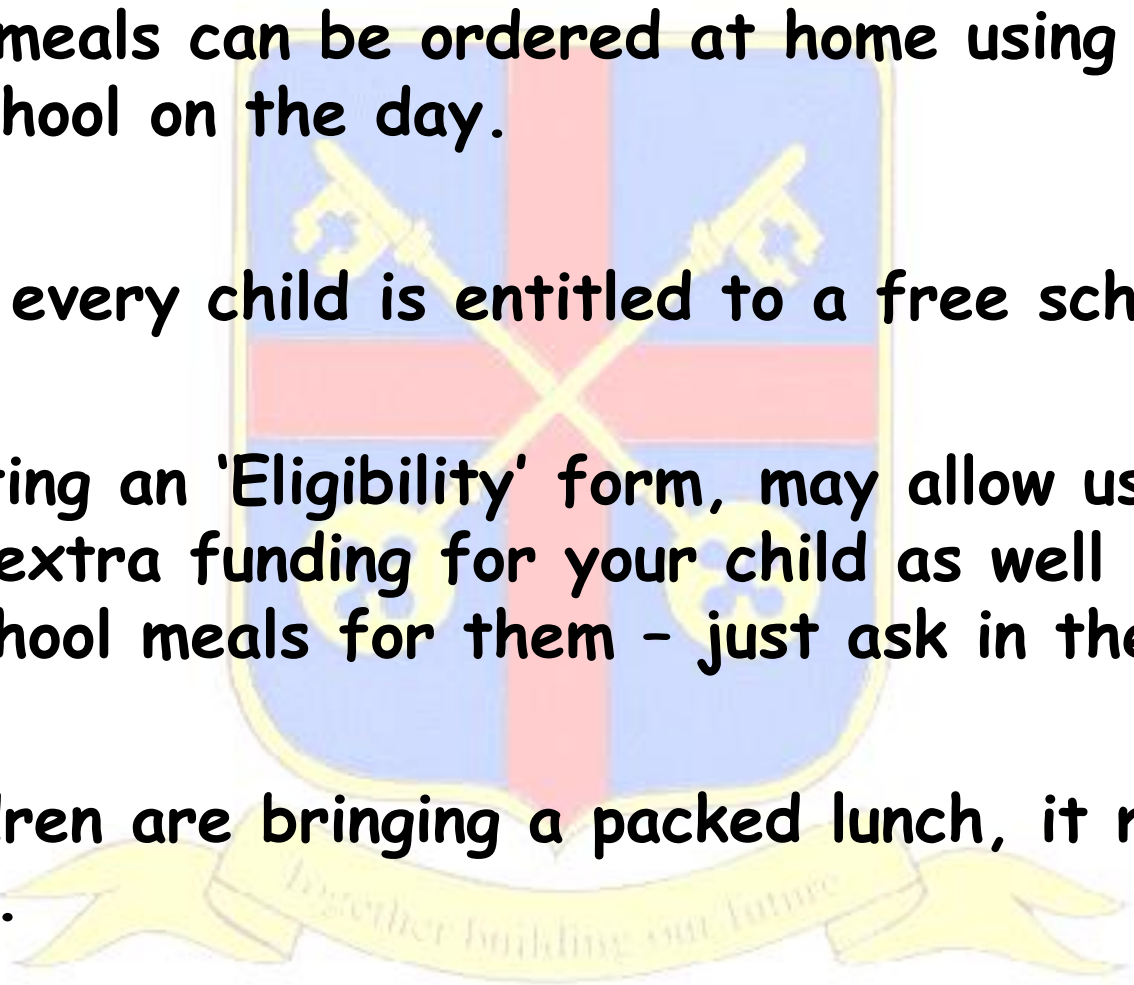

- If children are bringing a packed lunch, it must be healthy.

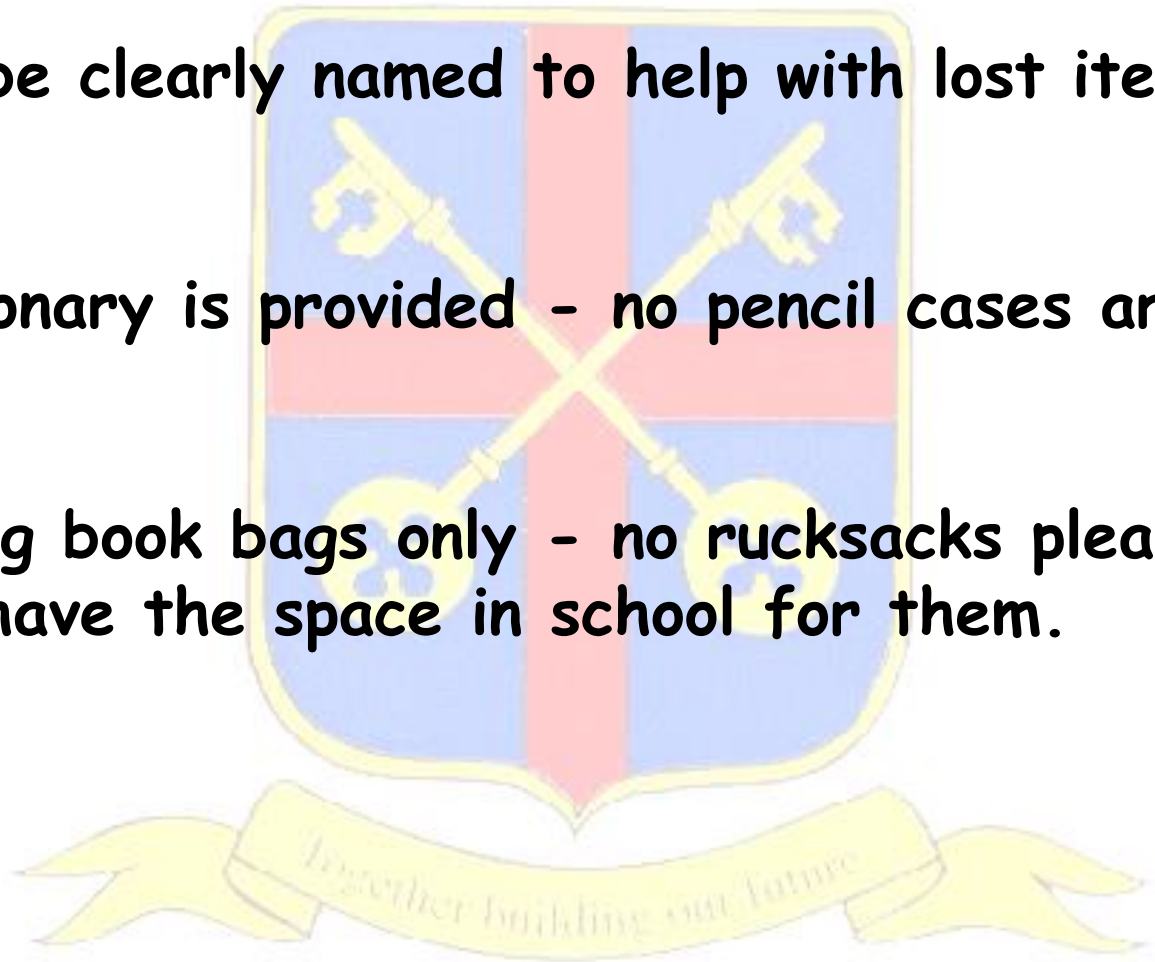


Snacks

- Milk and toast can be ordered online for term (priced at £1 per week). Milk can be ordered via 'coolmilk.com' for £1:55 per week (31p per day)
- Fruit is available everyday in keystage 1
- Healthy snacks can be brought from home.
- School will provide the new Bryn St Peter's water bottles this year, which can be left in school and refilled.

Equipment

- Must be clearly named to help with lost items.
- Stationary is provided - no pencil cases are needed
- Reading book bags only - no rucksacks please. We don't have the space in school for them.
