Know how many there are (up to 5) without counting.

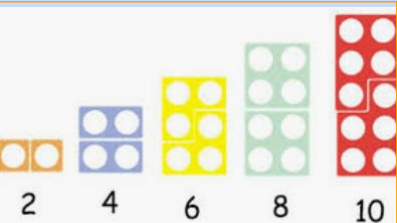


Count forwards to and backwards from ten. Count on and back from any number in this range. Order numbers to ten shown in different ways such as dotty pictures, tens frames or numerals.

Part-whole models are used, among others, to show how numbers can be split and combined.



Know doubles to five.

Know one more or less than a number.

One more is the number after...

4 is **one more** than 3

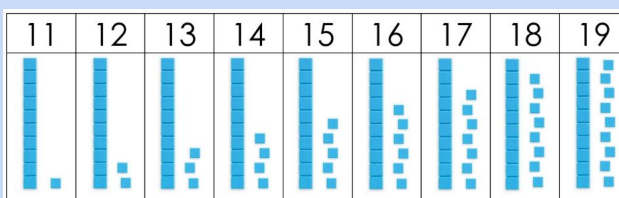


One less is the number before...

3 is **one less** than 4



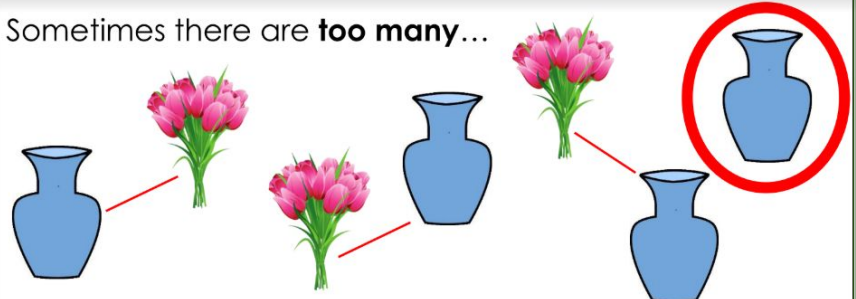
