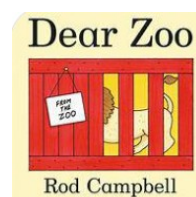
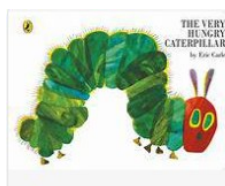
### Class Topic: It's Alive!
