<p><b>Reconciliation</b>                      “There is no limit to God’s grace, nor to God’s mercy and forgiveness when we fail. Reconciliation is a sacrament of healing. Reconciliation makes present Jesus’ call to conversion, involves contrition for our sins, confession of them to a priest, and absolution spoken by the priest in the name of Jesus Christ. In the celebration of the sacrament we acknowledge (confess) God’s holiness and mercy and are reconciled to God and the community of the Church.”</p> <p>Year 5 will learn that sin is a failure of love and learn that when we sin we hurt ourselves and others and damage our relationship with God.
