In English we will be learning about...

During our lessons we will be discussing our ideas with our friends and making sure our sentences make sense before we write them. Finally we will write our own versions of the story remembering to use our capital letters, full stops and spaces to write simple sentences.

We will also be using adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions such as when, if, because

Guided reading sessions will take place 3 times a week.

You can help your child by:

- Hearing them read daily for 10 minutes.
- Helping them to practise their spellings.
- Encouraging your child to take pride in the presentation of their homework.

In Maths we will be learning about...

Money

- counting coins and notes
- comparing different amounts of money
- finding different ways to make the same amount
- working out an amount of change
- solving problems

Multiplication and division

- deciding if groups are equal or unequal
- adding equal groups
- form multiplication sentences
- use arrays making equal group by grouping and sharing

You can help your child by:

- Encouraging them to access TT Rockstars at home.
- Helping them with their homework.

Homework

Reading: Please read with your child every day, even if it is a quick 10 minutes. Inside your child's book bag there is a reading record for you to fill in with any comments about your child's reading. Children will read at least once a week in school.

Reading books must come to school <u>every day</u>. That way, books can be changed when needed.

Other homework:

Homework will be set on a Friday to be handed in the following Wednesday. This will have either an English or Maths focus.

Spellings will also be sent home weekly for children to learn at home ready for a test on a Friday.
