- ✓ We have been learning more sounds in phonics! We have no learnt sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d. We have also started to make some words with the sounds, such as: map, tap, pan, man, pat, pit, sit, sat. I wonder if you can practise at home? Ask a grown up write some of our sounds onto pieces of paper and add the sounds together to make words.
- ✓ We have met Numberblocks 1,2,3 and explored making these numbers. We also made the Numberblock characters.
- ✓ We have talking a lot about our school rules and why need to have rules. We know they are to keep us and our classroom safe. We looked at the different behaviours and sorted them into things we should do and things we shouldn't do.
- ✓ We have been very busy making patterns and paintings, learning how to carefully use paintbrushes and wash brushes between colours.
