

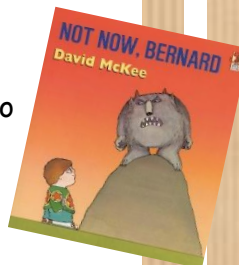


Reception Class Weekly Newsletter
