This week...

- ✓ Our key text has been "Here comes Jack Frost". We have really enjoyed sharing this story and learning about hibernating animals, discussing the seasons and exploring friendship.
- ✓ We have been looking at numbers within 5 (consolidation). We have played a catch the dots game where we had to round up the numbers shown on the dice. We played "higher or lower" with big playing cards and beat Mrs Owen in a competition. We learnt how to record scores using tally marks.
- ✓ We have continued phase 3 phonics, spelling and name writing as part of English. We have also been completing simple sentences using key words.
- ✓ We looked at cold colours and created some beautiful frost artwork based on the illustrations in Jack Frost.
- ✓ In PE we put out full kits on for the first time!! Everyone was brilliant at getting dressed all by themselves. We've had another two exciting PE lessons used equipment to learn balancing, jumping and landing safely. There were some items of uniform without a name in, meaning children were mixing up their clothes. Please help them out by adding names to all items of clothing.
