This half term, we will be learning about The Romans in history and all about light in science.

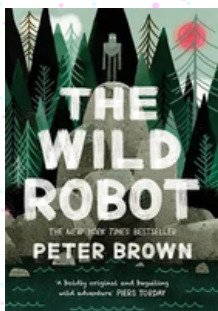
