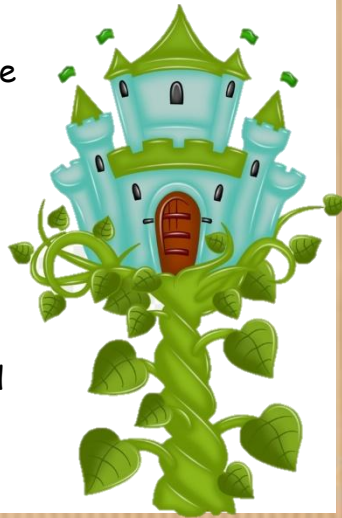


Reception Class Weekly Newsletter

This week...

- ✓ We had a mysterious plant growing from our roof! And a delivery of some little plants in plant pots. We made predictions of what they might be, drawing on our knowledge of things that grow from plants.
- ✓ The big plant on the roof seemed to be getting bigger every day! It inspired our Drawing Club text 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We have been learning the story, writing about the Giant and his castle, and listening to different versions of this traditional tale looking at similarities and differences.
- ✓ In Art we have been exploring the Japanese printing technique called Tataki Zome. This involves using flowers and leaves, and printing them by hammering between two sheets of paper or fabric, displaying the natural colours from the plants.
