# In Maths we are learning about...

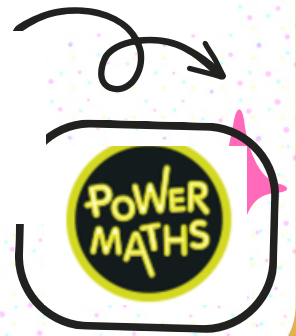
use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line and distinguishing and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anti-clockwise)

order and arrange combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences

interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables

ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity

ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data

**Spelling:** Children will be set spellings on a Tuesday to be tested the following Monday.
