In outdoor PE we will be learning invasion games skills and applying them to handball and indoor PE will be a gymnastics focus on moving in different pathways.

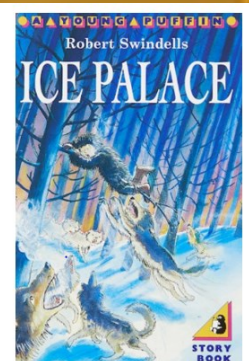
In DT we will be looking at where in the world our food comes from and preparing some healthy snacks.

This half term we will be looking at each different continent and learning about features of some of the countries that are within them.

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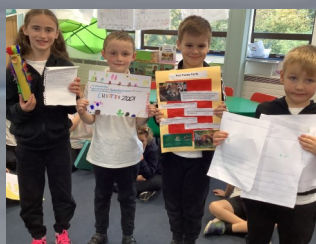
