

Careers Newsletter Year 11 - Term 1

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Faye delivers 'Independent Advice and Guidance' for our students and families. Please get in touch with Faye or your child's House Team if you would like to discuss your child's options at post-16 education.

As part of our careers programme, each Year 11 student will be given the opportunity to attend a 1:1 appointment with Faye to think about their Next Steps.

Faye visits our school for a number of days every half term. Students are given a 1:1 meeting to discuss ideas for their future plans regarding education and work.

Initial 1:1 appointments will focus on post-16 transition, and Faye will talk with students about their aspirations for college and beyond.

Faye will give a short presentation, and will be available to talk to parents/carers and students, at the Y11 Post-16 information evening which will be held at JPC 5-6 p.m. on Thursday 25th September.

Many local colleges hold their Open Evenings around this time of year, so make sure you look out for any that may be of interest.

In the Y11 timetabled LFL Mentor-led lessons, students will also look at college websites, and will be visiting some local colleges also.
