Dear Parents and Carers,

Geography Trip to Loggerheads Country Park- 17th June 2026

GCSE Geography students will be attending their first fieldwork trip to Loggerheads on June 17th. The GCSE requires two days of fieldwork to be undertaken and students will be questioned on their data collection and data analysis methods in the GCSE exams, meaning it is important that students attend.

Students will be collecting data on rivers, and will need to collect data in small groups, including entering the river to collect width, depth, velocity and bedload size results. It is, therefore, important that students wear appropriate clothing (waterproof coats, leggings etc) and footwear, such as wellies or walking shoes. We will have some spare wellies and waterproofs with us. Students also need to bring a backpack to carry their lunch and equipment for the trip.

Please note the following details regarding this trip:

- Students will travel to and from Loggerheads by minibus.
- We will leave school at 9.40 am and return at 2.30pm.
- Students will need to bring a packed lunch; lunches will be provided by the school for those who receive school lunches.

At Loggerheads, there are toilet facilities very close to the data collection site and a small gift shop/cafe should students want to purchase a drink or snack. Students will not be allowed to purchase hot food, as we will not have time to facilitate this.
