

What we are learning this term...

Year 5

Autumn 1

In English, we will explore some poetry and narrative writing. Our class book is Disaster at Sea by John Marriott. In maths, we will extend our place value knowledge up to 1,000,000 and revisit our knowledge of formal written methods for addition and subtraction as well as strengthening our fluency skills. Our science topic, we will be building on learning from year 3 by developing an understanding of how forces including gravitational attraction and drag forces—such as friction, air/water resistance and upthrust can affect movement. In our religion lessons, we will be exploring Sikhism thinking about how far a Sikh would go for their religion. We will be focusing on our geographical knowledge of the UK and creating some artwork inspired by Vi-



kings. Our focus in music will be rock anthems and in Spanish we will be exploring pets. Our PSHE learning will focus on mental and emotional health.

Autumn 2



In English, we will continue to build on and develop our writing skills over a range of genres. Our class book will be Onyeka and the Academy of the Sun. In maths, our learning will focus on graphs and tables, multiplication and division to use this knowledge to calculate area and perimeter. For our Spanish learning this half term, we will turn our focus to the months of the year and saying when our birthdays are. In DT, we will analyse different bridge structures to help us design, make and evaluate our own designs. For History this half term, we will explore the Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons in Britain. Our religion focus for this half term will be Christianity, thinking about the story of Christmas. In science, we will extend our understanding of

everyday materials, examining different properties and why this makes them suitable for different uses. Our PSHE

Year 6

Autumn 1

In English, we will explore some poetry and narrative writing. Our class book is Keeper by Alan Gibbons. In maths, we will extend our place value knowledge up to 10,000,000 and revisit our knowledge of formal written methods for addition and subtraction as well as strengthening our fluency skills. Our science topic is classification of living things, we will be thinking about similarities and differences between various characteristics of living things. In our religion lessons, we will be exploring Islam thinking about what are the best ways for Muslims to show their commitment to their faith. We will be focusing on our geographical knowledge of extreme weather phenomena and finding out about what happens when a volcano erupts as well as developing our mark— making skills to create portraits inspired by Mike Barrett. Our focus in music will be pop/neo-soul and being happy and in Spanish we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of verb stems and regular verbs. Our PSHE learning will focus on mental and emotional health.



Autumn 2



In English, we will continue to build on and develop our writing skills over a range of genres. Our class book will be Windrush child by Benjamin Zephaniah. In maths, we will strengthen our understanding of fractions and explore position and direction in geometry. For our Spanish learning this half term, we will turn our focus to school subjects and saying what we study. In DT, we will investigate and analyse items made using textiles and different ways of joining and decorating materials before making our own item. For History this half term, we will explore the history of World War 1. Our religion focus for this half term will be Christianity, thinking about whether Christmas celebrations and traditions help Christians to understand who Jesus was and why he was born. In science, we will be looking at identifying parts of the human circulatory system and describe what the functions of the heart are.

Our PSHE focus for this half term will be living in the wider world.
