PE will be on a **Monday (indoor)** and **Thursday (outdoor)**, but children can bring in PE kits on a Monday and take them home on Friday. P.E kits should include pumps or trainers, black shorts, tracksuit bottoms for cold weather and a white t-shirt. Please ensure that your child does not wear tracksuit bottoms for indoor PE as they will not be allowed on the apparatus and that all PE kit and school uniform is clearly named.

- In year 5, children will have the opportunity to start or continue with their instrument lessons which includes; flute, clarinet, recorder and steel pans
