As part of our PSHE / RSE learning this term, the children will learn about how to be safe on the roads, learn about cyber bullying and how to administer first aid for bites and stings.

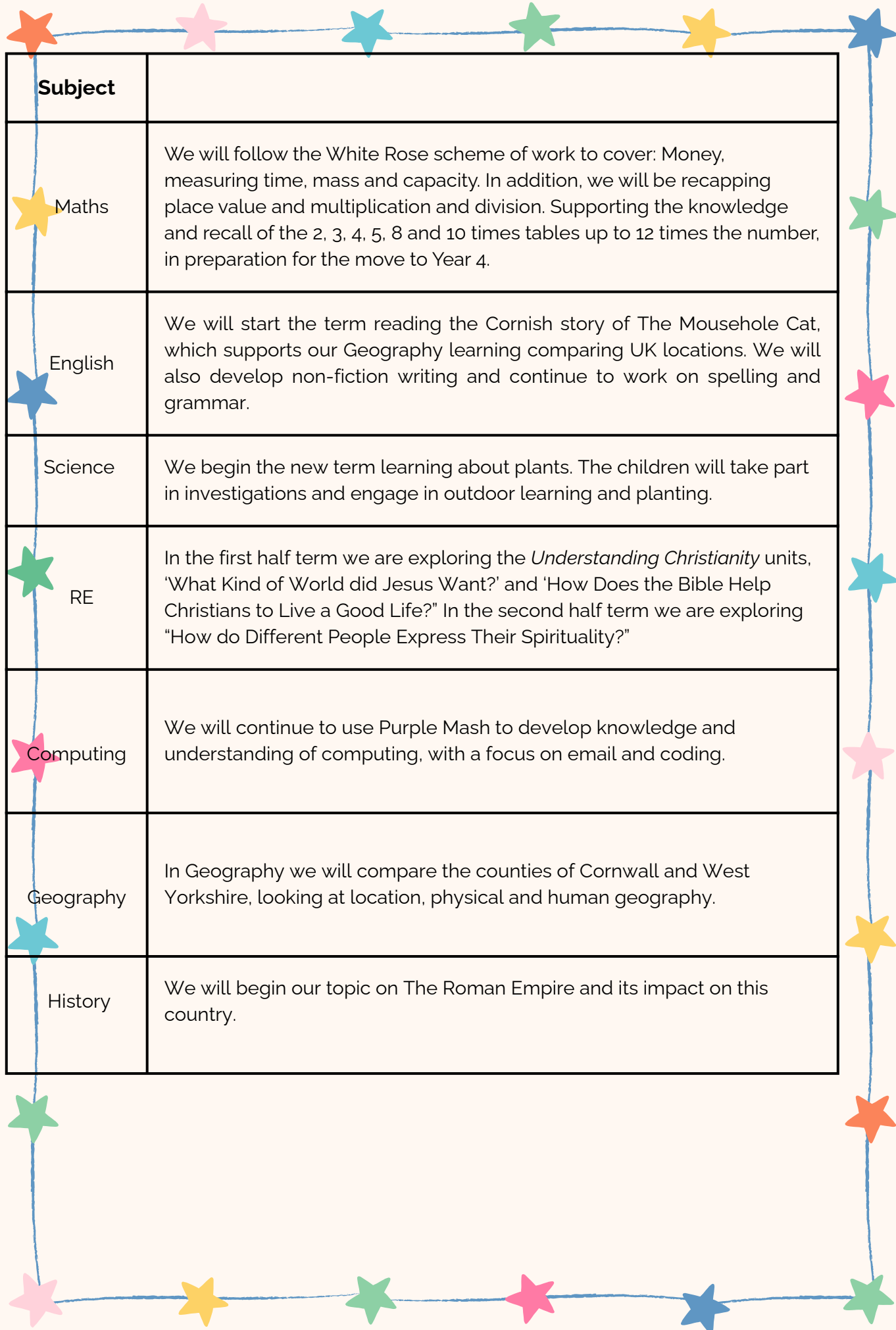



Design Technology	The children will complete a textiles project linked to topic work and cook food linked to our Geography topic work.
Art	The children will complete creative projects linked to our work on environmental themes and responses to the work of artists.
