Our learning

This week we are basing our learning all around Valentines day. We will be making cards, crafts and biscuits and talking about who we love and why and how that makes us feel. We will also be talking about why we are special and what we love about ourselves 

In phonics Nursery are continuing on phase 1 and will learning how to recognise different sounds
Reception will be continuing with phase 3 and learning new sounds: igh, oa, oo/oo

We will be blending the sounds together to read a simple cvc (consonant-vowel-consonant) word. You can find an example of this here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=lrGgCx5_MQs Alphablocks on cbeebies also blends sounds to make a word and is a great resource. Learning to read takes time, the most successful children are the ones that practise at home.
