### Message

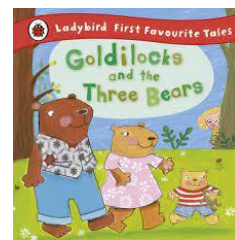
Dear EY1 children and their families,
