Phonics

In phonics we have been recapping lots of the diagraphs we have learnt already and recapping the tricky words we have learnt. This week we have focused on **ai ur and or** sounds as well as becoming confident reading words with **th ch sh and ng**.

<u>Maths</u>

We have moved on to learning about the numbers 9 and 10. We have learnt about ordering and sequencing numbers to 10 and have made our own numberlines and this week are learning to make 9 and 10 in different ways.

Shared Learning Opportunities

Home learning: Discuss with your child what they would like to be when they grow up maybe you could talk about the different jobs their family members may have. Or maybe you could spot the different jobs they may see on the way to school, i.e. post person, deliver drive etc. Please see the home learning sheet below for some phonics practice.

Show and Tell: Children can bring in something that they would like to be when they grow up. It could be a prop from a costume, a book about their favourite occupation, or a photo from a visit to a museum etc (please just bring one item at a time)
