Our learning

In phonics Nursery are continuing on phase 1 and will learning how to recognise different sounds Reception will be continuing with phase 2 and learning new sounds: h b f/ff l/ll ss We will be blending the sounds together to read a simple cvc (consonant-vowel-consonant) word. You can find an example of this here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=lrGgCx5_MQs Alphablocks on cbeebies also blends sounds to make a word and is a great resource. Learning to read takes time, the most successful children are the ones that practise at home.

In Maths we will be learning how to add one more to an amount.
