











Year 6  
Curriculum Leaflet  
Summer Term Two

Subject	What we will be learning about
<p><b>Writing</b></p> 	<p>In <b>English</b>, we will complete our class novel, <b>The Boy at the Back of the Class</b>. The children will continue to create writing based on this learning which will contain passionate and persuasive styles of text, as well as compiling poetry and informative pieces.</p> <p>As our end of year production descends upon us, we will be spending quite a bit of our time rehearsing in the hall. Obviously, their speaking and listening skills are developed significantly through this use of drama.</p>
<p><b>Reading</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The children will also continue with My Book Blog where they will have time to read their books and reflect upon its content and vocabulary. They will also complete tasks on the class novel in this session too.</li> <li>• We will also read a range of short stories including The Nightmare Hour by RL Stein and The White Horse of Zennor by Michael Morpurgo.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This half term we will focus on repeated patterns using circumference, diameter and radius knowledge as well as developing angle and measurement skills.</li> <li>• The children will also be taught how to apply the formula for pi so that they can calculate the area of the circle which contains their pattern.</li> <li>• The children have also been asked to take part in an enterprise scheme to see if they generate profit from £5. They will be bringing home a letter about this exciting project</li> </ul>
<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our <b>Art</b> project this half term is with our resident artist Mr Hall. The children will study create a 'memory box' using repeated patterns based on William Morris. These patterns will then be printed on to a cube net so that that they can build their own box. These are a lovely keep-sake for the children to take home at the end of year.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our topic this half term is: We are dinosaur hunters</li> </ul> <p>We will explore:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The rise of the dinosaurs</li> <li>• Evolution of the dinosaurs</li> <li>• Fossils</li> <li>• Scientific enquiry</li> <li>• The end of the dinosaurs</li> </ul>
<p><b>PE</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lessons will continue each <b>Friday</b> – Full PE kits to be worn please. This half term we will learn the rules for and play games of rounders as well as developing our athletic skills.</li> </ul>

<b>RE</b> 	<p><b>What</b></p> <p>This half term we will be revisiting some of the previous topics covered such as Humanism, architecture and the role of influential leaders.</p> <p>We will link some of our work to transition and explore how beliefs and belief systems can help or possibly hinder the process. We will also look at specifically at the idioms, 'the grass is greener' and 'You never know what you've got till it's gone'</p>
<b>History</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What did the Ancient Greeks do for us?</li> <li>• The children will learn about the chronology of the Ancient Greeks from 800BC to 100BC. They will learn about the different periods and how ideas and strategies generated over 2000years ago still apply today. We will look at architecture and the Olympics games as well as learn about some of their Gods, Goddesses and heroes.</li> </ul>
<b>PSHE</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This half term our focus will be on 'Changing Me'. We will discuss healthy body image and the changes which occur during puberty. The School Nurses Team will be coming into school to deliver a specific session for Year 6 pupils. Further details will be sent out about this closer to the time.</li> </ul>
<b>French</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In our French lessons we will focus on WWII.</li> <li>• The children will apply their prior knowledge of this topic so that they can write letters as a WWII evacuee in French.</li> </ul>

<b>Home Learning</b>	<b>You can help at home by</b>
<b>Spellings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practising my spellings with me.</li> <li>• They will be handed out each</li> <li>• They will be tested each</li> </ul>
<b>Maths</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accessing Key Stage 3 BBC Revise Wise and play games associated with learning in preparation for high school.</li> <li>• Supporting your child with the Enterprise scheme by assisted them to buy the resources they need.</li> </ul>
<b>Reading</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading with me at least 4 times per week</li> <li>• Completing My Book Blog after the given chapters.</li> <li>• Making sure that I change my book in the class library when I am ready to.</li> </ul>
<b>Homework Project</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Checking what the homework project is and when the deadline is.</li> <li>• Making sure that I start my research for the project in plenty of time and that I make a start sooner rather than later.</li> <li>• Making sure that I bring my project into school by the deadline.</li> </ul>
