Classroom Highlights

Nursery have been thinking about the exciting changes ahead as they prepare to become Reception children in September. Through their PSHE lessons, they enjoyed sharing their ideas and taking part in thoughtful discussions about what the new school year will bring.

This week, **Reception** have been practising their number bonds to 10, with some children challenging themselves to learn number bonds to 20. They have also enjoyed learning about the human body and how our bodies grow and change.

Year 1 have been busy exploring different materials in Science, learning about their properties and how they are used in everyday life. In Maths, they have been developing their understanding of time and are becoming increasingly confident at telling o'clock and half-past times.

This week in **Year 2**, we enjoyed our Sport's Day and the children had a fabulous time racing against one another. There were some hilarious moments with the hoops and the egg and spoon race but most importantly the children had tremendous fun!

Year 3 enjoyed sharing their thoughts on Truthfulness during their Church visit and celebrated with a well-earned snack afterwards. In Science, they learned about transpiration in plants, while in Reading they are eagerly reaching the end of Operation Gadgetman. In Maths, the children have completed their data unit and are now exploring fractions of shapes and numbers.

Year 4 have combined their learning in English and Science this week by writing informative explanation texts about sound. They have explored how sound is created through vibrations and how it travels all the way to the human ear, showing a fantastic understanding of this fascinating scientific process.

This week in **Year 5**, the children have been busy planning their own original playscripts. Next week, they will have the opportunity to bring their ideas to life by writing and, if they choose, performing their plays for others.

This week, **Year 6** welcomed the school nurse, who led an informative session about the changes children will experience as they grow. The children listened well and asked thoughtful questions. We also performed our first dress rehearsal of the Year 6 production in front of a live audience. Everyone showed great confidence and enthusiasm, and we are looking forward to our final performances!

We reflected on how recognising and celebrating the strengths of others helps us to build friendships, show respect and encourage one another.

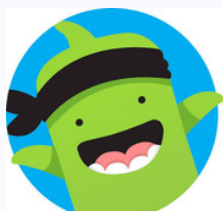
We finished by thinking about our big question:
