A board with rows of buttons called keys you can press to write letters or numbers on a computer screen.



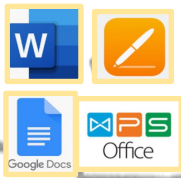
Laptop

When you change so you can live better in your home or environment.

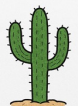
Example:

A camel adapts by storing water in its hump.



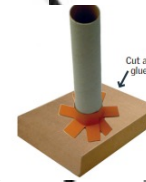
A cactus adapts by having spines to protect it.

A 3D object made of different parts joined together, often for strength and stability.



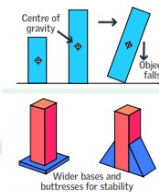
Freestanding Structure

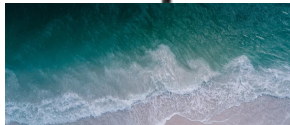
UK
