Gas:

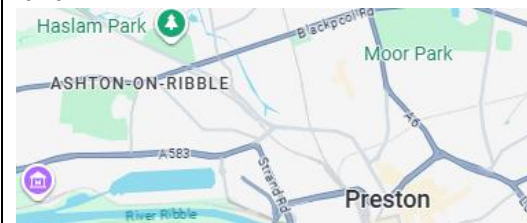
Challenge: Can you find a material at home that can be in different states?

We will be looking at loads of maps to understand the city, the local area and the different uses of land.

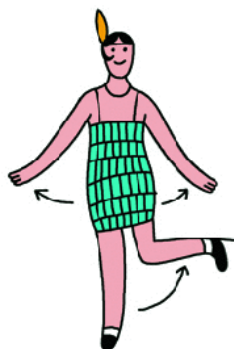


Draw a map showing your route to school, or your route to some other local place?
