ENGLISH:

2. Write your own story called 'My African adventure'. Include a title, your name as the author and a picture of what might happen in the story. Challenge yourself and write about two events that might happen in the story.

MATHS:

Find out about some 2D and 3D shapes.

Draw some 2D shapes and label how many sides and corners they have.

Draw some 3D shapes and label how many edges, faces and vertices they have.

HISTORY:

Find out what toys your grandparents played with when they were young. Did they have phones? What was their favorite toy? Draw pictures of their favorite toys from when they were young.
