Class routines:

Reading books

Geography:

This half-term will be exploring the continent of Africa, with a specific focus on the country of Kenya! We will look at the different human and physical features as well as exploring the wildlife, climate and landscape. We will finish off by comparing the city of Nairobi to London to see how similar/different they are.

English:

This half term we will be listening to two different stories that are very similar – Little Red Riding Hood and Little Red Reading Hood. We will look at our traditional tale before moving on to the twisted version. We will be retelling our story before innovating it to make it our own.

Religious Education:

This half-term we are learning about Christianity. Our focus question will look at what unites the Christian community. We will explore worship, the church and the use of symbolism.

Music:

This half-term we will continue to learn how to play glockenspiels!

PE:

This half-term our PE day is **Tuesday** and our focus is striking for accuracy. We will be using rackets, balls and shuttlecocks.

Art

This half-term we will be exploring how we can make a sculpture using natural material. This work will be inspired by the artist Andy Goldsworthy. We will be discussing the artist's work and looking at what material would work best for our sculptures.

Computing:

This half-term we will be finding out how we can collect data. We will look at how data can be used to help answer questions and gather our data using a tally chart and present it using different tools.

Mathematics:

We will continue to learn about multiplication and division structures. As part of this children will be practicing their 2, 5 and 10 times tables especially skip counting! Let's see who can become our skip counting champion.

Science:

We are learning about what the weather is like in Preston in the Spring. This links with our previous work on the weather in Preston in the Autumn and Winter and hopefully we see a change! Children will gather and record data on the weather as well as exploring what we wear in Spring.
