### Digestive system

breaks down the food we eat into tiny parts to give us fuel and nutrients we need to live.

### Molar

Large, flat teeth found at the very back of the mouth used for crushing and grinding food into smaller pieces.

### Incisor

Eight flat, sharp-edged teeth at the front of the mouth.

### Canine

Four sharp, slightly pointed, and the longest teeth on either side of the front four teeth, on the top and bottom.

## Geography Fridge Words

### Longitude

A set of imaginary lines that run vertically from the North Pole to the South Pole

### Latitude

The distance north or south of the equator.

### Hemisphere

The division of the globe into two equal halves - northern and southern hemisphere.

### Poles

Two opposite fixed points on Earth's surface.

### Tropics

The hot humid regions near the equator.

### Time zones

There are 24 time zones.

## Art Fridge Words

### Scale

The size of an artwork linking to its surroundings.

### Tone

How light or dark a colour is.

### Tertiary colours

Mixing a primary colour with a secondary colour.

### Tint

A lighter version of a colour, created by adding white to the original colour.

### Shade

A lighter version of a colour, often used to create depth.
