

Summer 1 Nursery Home Learning

Communication & Language

Go outside and play games such as 'I Spy' and 'I Hear'.

Go outside and look at the different things you can see. Collect some different flowers or leaves. Can you sort them into different colours?

Use your voice to make different sounds. Can you make sounds like a dog or a car?

Talk about your favourite vegetables. Why do you like them? Tell someone about the vegetables you don't like, why don't you like them? Try a vegetable you've never tasted before, tell someone about it. Do you like it?

Literacy

Read your favourite story and retell the story to your Mum, Dad, Grandma, Grandad, friend. Draw a picture of your favourite part. Why is it your favourite part of the story?

Come Outside

Writing-

Practise writing/mark making your name in some mud or sand.

Can you write the initial letter from your name e.g Ben - B

Expressive Art and Design

Go on a nature walk to gather items like leaves, shells and twigs to create a collage. *Can you tell a grown up what your collage is?*

Maths-

Have a look at any vegetables that you have at home. How many different vegetables do you have?

Can you count the number of vegetables you have?

Which vegetable is the heaviest? Which vegetable is the lightest?

Can you make a repeating pattern with the vegetables?

Roll a dice and see if you can count to the number shown.

Roll a dice, identify the number then find the correct number of objects.

Phonics Listening – listen to some music at home, can you clap along with the beat.

Make your own noisemakers – collect some different objects together that make different noises and put them in a bag or a box. Use one of the objects to make a noise for someone else to guess what it is.
