We hope this message finds you well and eager for the exciting half term ahead! We have a lot of plans leading up to the end of the school year, and we can't wait to share it with you.

Our Topic: Oh I do like to be beside the seaside

For the next half term, our focus will revolve around the themes of Pirates and the seaside. We're diving into stories like "Pirates Love Underpants" and finding out about the seaside in the past by exploring non-fiction texts.

Literacy Learning: Retelling Stories

In literacy, we'll be immersing ourselves in the enchanting world of storytelling. We'll delve into the adventures of Pirates, examining characters, settings, and plotlines. Our goal is to help your child develop their storytelling skills and confidently retell these beloved tales in their own words.

Mathematics Exploration: Number Bonds to 10

In mathematics, we're focusing on the foundational concept of number bonds to 10 and beyond. Through hands-on activities and interactive exercises, students will explore different ways of making numbers up to 10, understand positional language, and identify shapes with 3, 4, and 5 sides. We'll also emphasise counting on and back from different numbers, laying the groundwork for deeper mathematical understanding.

Phonics and Reading: Phase 3 and Reading Practice

We are consolidating graphemes and strengthening reading and spelling skills. Daily reading practice is essential, and we encourage you to engage your child with their home reader, explore their favourite books together, and practise tricky words and sounds.
