

Year 6 Curriculum Information

ENGLISH

This half term, our class novel will be a narrative version of 'Macbeth' by John Blake. The children will be focussing on developing stamina for writing across a range of genres. The Year 6s will also be learning the script for the Year 6 leavers' production.

The children will continue to develop their skills in reading and responding to texts and will continue to extend their knowledge of spelling patterns.

MATHS

This term begins with a topic on factors. We will then move on to converting units and angles. Alongside these topics we will be working daily on improving our speed and accuracy in our times tables.

If your child is still not confident with their times tables, it would be great if they could practise at home as this will help them immensely, especially as they move to Year 6 or Year 7 in September.

CURRICULUM

Geography – Our topic this term is 'Our Changing World' where children will discover some of the many ways in which the world around them is changing - from coastal erosion to political changes. They will learn about the structure of the United Kingdom and how its shape and geography have changed over thousands of years.

PE – PE this term will be striking and fielding for Year 6 and swimming for Year 5. Year 6 children need to come to school in their PE kits on a **Tuesday**. Year 5 swimming lessons will take place on **Tuesday** mornings and so Year 5 children will need to bring their swimming costume, a towel and a hat in a separate bag on this day.

R.E – Following the question we have been looking at all year of, 'In what ways is life like a journey?' the children will be looking at Islam and specifically *What is Hajj and why is it important to Muslims?*

Science – In Science this half-term, we will continue our learning about The Heart and the Circulatory System and look at how diet and exercise affect the body.

HOME LEARNING

It is really important that children read regularly at home. Although children must read their school reading book, they are also encouraged to read for pleasure by choosing books that are of interest to them. This can include non-fiction books, magazines, comics and newspapers as well as fictional stories.

A link to the homework for the term will be put on the Ash Class webpage and on Class Dojo. Children should complete one homework of choice from the list each week and can post a document or photograph of the completed learning on Class Dojo if they wish.
