Can you complete them all?

GEOGRAPHY:

Become a seaside explorer. Pick a seaside town (this could be one you have visited before or a local one e.g. Blackpool, Lytham) and tell us some facts about it e.g. Where in the UK is it? What physical/human features can you see? Draw a picture of what you might do there. How is it similar/different to where we live in Preston.

SCIENCE:

Draw four pictures to show what a person might wear in all four seasons so that they are prepared for the weather. Maybe instead of drawing you could take pictures of yourself wearing clothes for Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.

MATHS:

Fractions challenge! Look around your home for objects that can be split into equal parts. Can you find or draw:

Something that shows $\frac{1}{2}$

Something that shows $\frac{1}{4}$

Something that shows $\frac{3}{4}$

These might include toys, food or shapes you can draw yourself.
