Year 5 Trip to Tatton Park: Viking and Anglo-Saxon Experience Day

As part of our History curriculum we have arranged to visit Tatton Park on Wednesday 11th March to experience and learn about Viking and Anglo-Saxon life in Britain. Children will learn about these two groups of people, looking at their home life, religion, work, trade, food, language and geography. We will arrive at the time of the Viking raids and through activities will see the effects on the Anglo-Saxon community. The day will be led by historical characters and include exciting, hands-on activities to truly understand what life was like at this time.

We will be leaving school at 9:30am and travelling by coach to Tatton Park. We will return to school for the end of the school day. The cost of the trip is £17.60 per child, which can be paid via Gateway. Children will need to wear school uniform for this trip; however due to the outdoor activities taking place, outdoor shoes such as trainers would be advisable. Please ensure your child brings a coat and a water bottle with them.

Children must bring a packed lunch with them for this trip. If you would like to order a school packed lunch for your child, all orders must be made by Wednesday 4th March using the reply slip below. Following Natasha's Law, packed lunches cannot be ordered from the kitchen on the day of the trip.

Please return the permission slip by Monday 2nd March. We welcome parent volunteers to accompany us on our trip. If you are available, and would like to join us, please indicate this on the slip. We will confirm with you if we require your assistance.
