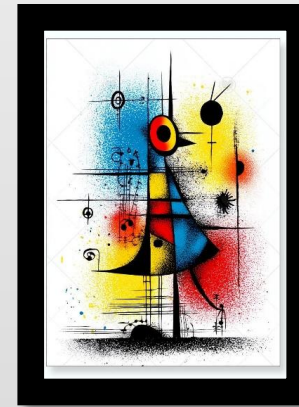

Miro was a Spanish artist, who was inspired by the artwork created by children. Many of his pieces of art are done in the style of children's artwork.



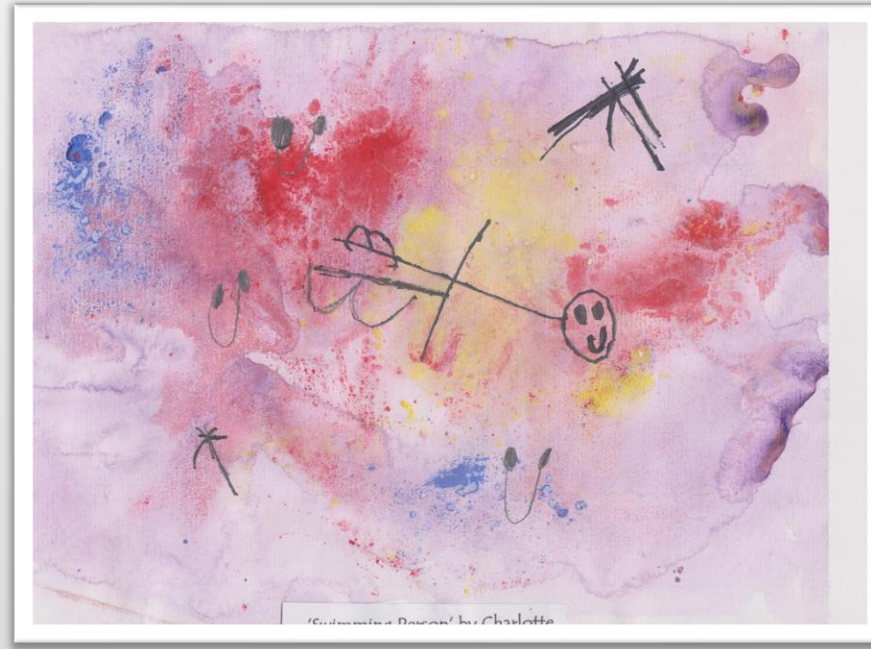

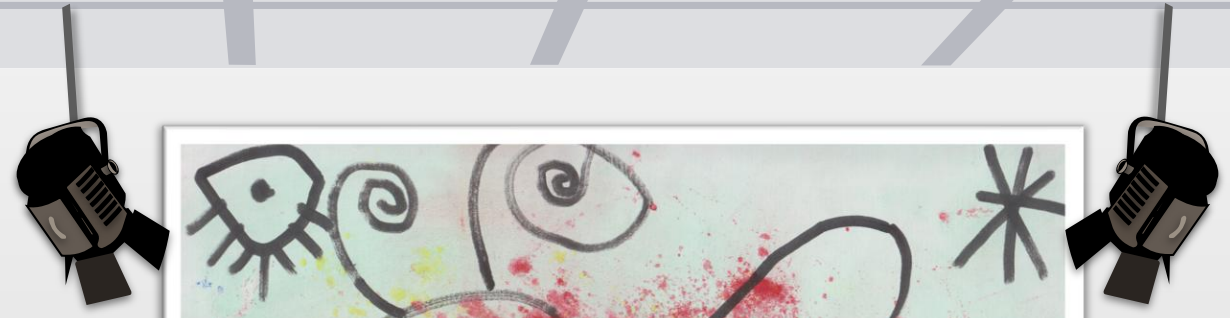

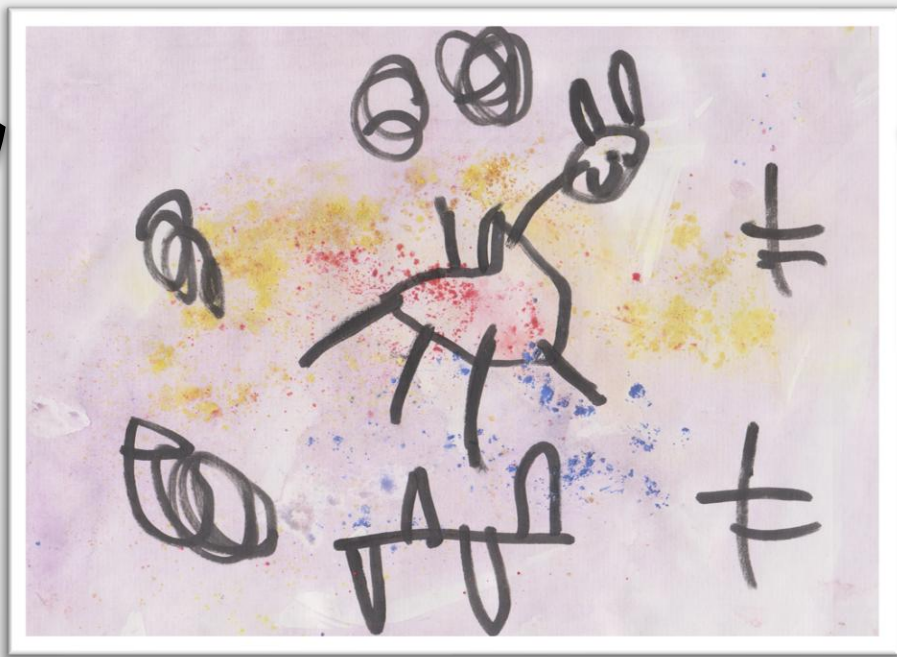

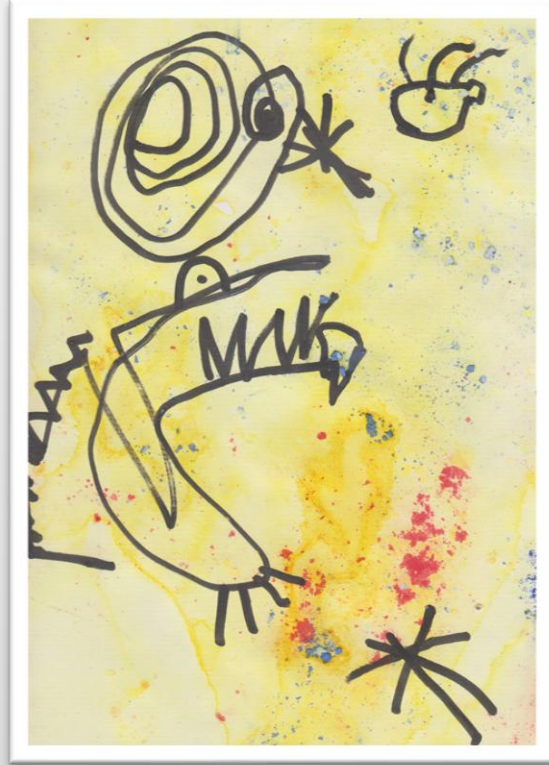

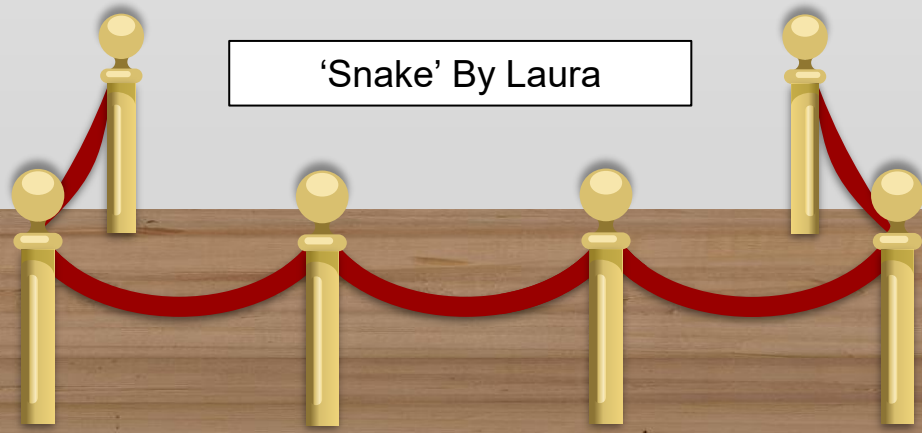

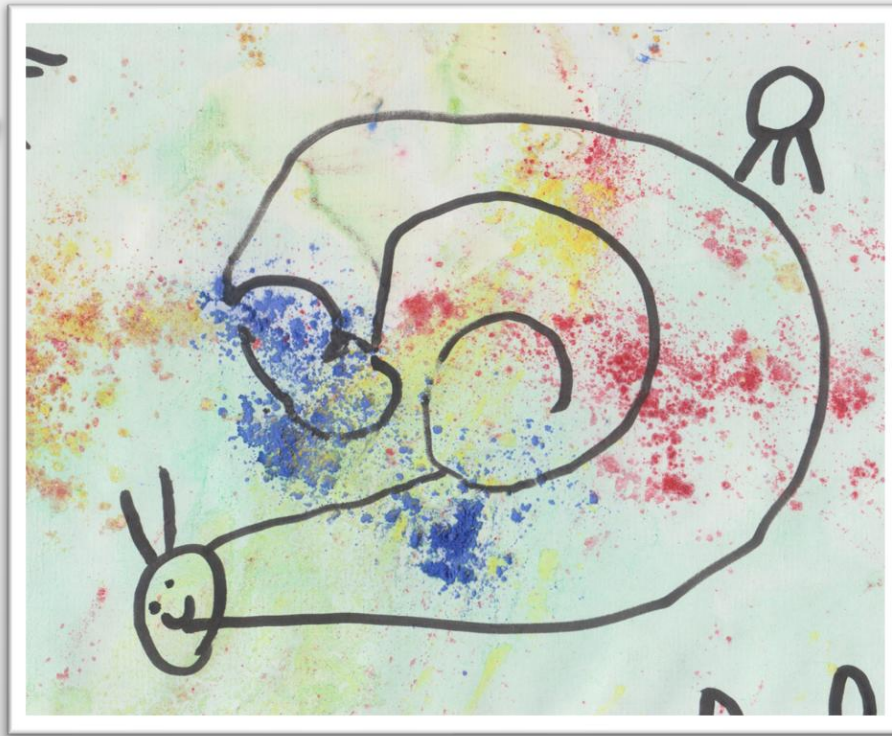
