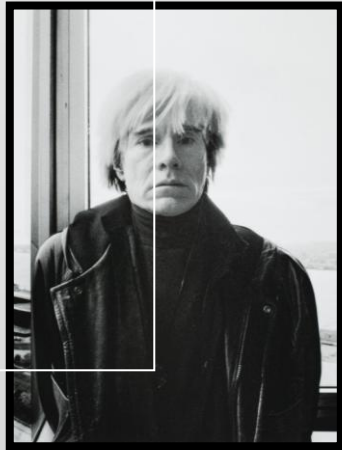


Andy Warhol was a Pop Artist. He used a technique called printing to create a repeating pattern of any image he liked.



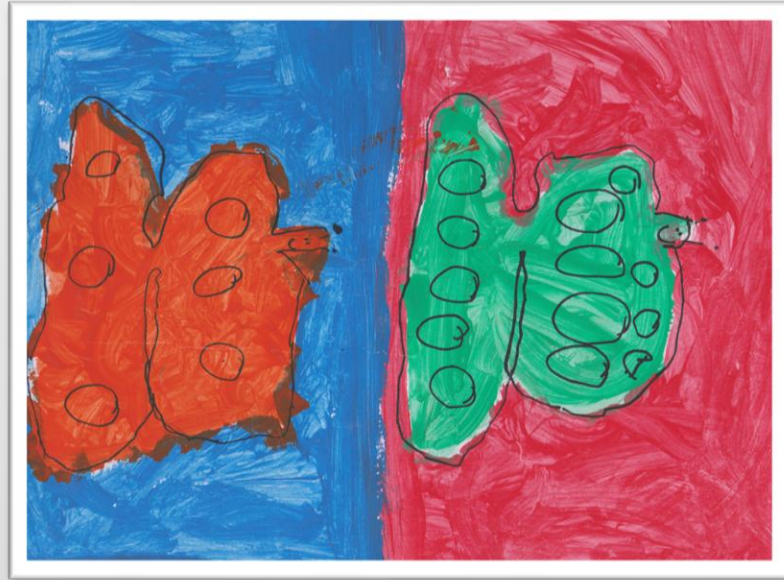

He created lots of famous repeated images, some of famous people like Marylin Monroe or even of food. In his pictures, he liked to use bright, eye-catching colours.

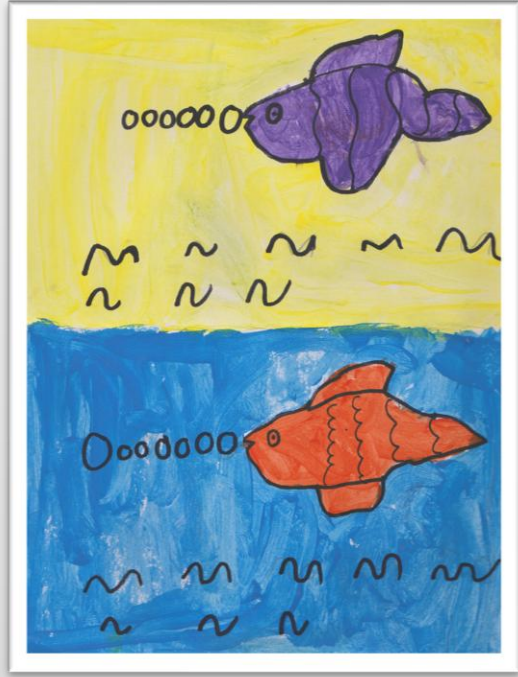
In **year 1**, we decided to try his repeating technique on our animal drawings.
