Inspired by her style, the children created their own animal artworks, carefully considering colour,

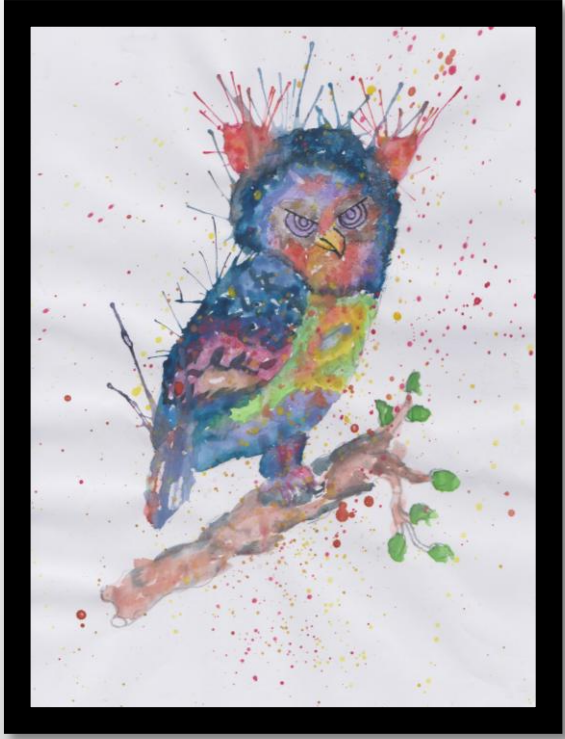
composition and texture to show personality and character in their work.
