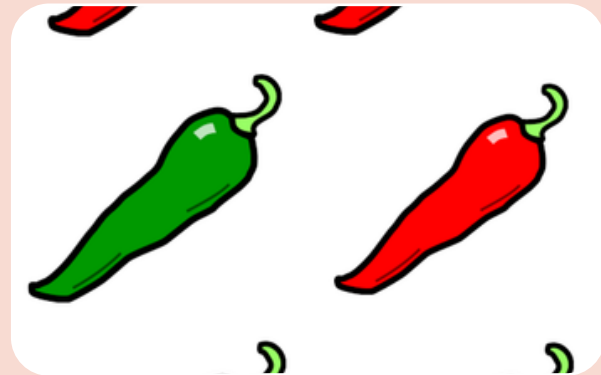
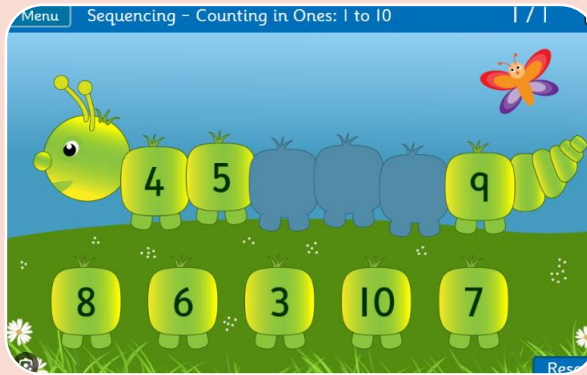


**TOPIC: Where can the Naughty Bus go in our school or grounds?**
