This term we will be exploring changes in living memory by looking at how the local area and our school has changed.

# Welcome back!

I hope you have all had a great summer breank and are ready for the busy but exciting year ahead.

Moving to Key Stage 1 from EYFS can feel like a big change, but please be assured that all adults in the class are committed to making the transition as smooth as possible.

Year 1 have the exciting topic of changes in living memory. Will be looking at how our school has changed, how the experiences children have at school have changed and finding out about the past in the local area.

In English we will begin by becoming familiar with the story Last Stop on Market Street by Matt De La Pena and Christian Robinson. This is a beautiful story about findung beauty in the everyday. We will be using it as a stimulus for own writing. Looking at how we can improve our sentence writing.

In Maths, we will begin by looking at place value with Numbers to 10. We will then develop our undersdtanding by moving onto addition and subtraction withing 10. Finishing with an exploration of 2D and 3D shapes.

Our first Science topic is 'Animals Including Humans'. We will learn about the features of different animals, their habitats and what they eat.

In art we will be creating work based on that of Hunterwasser. In Music we will be telling stories through music. Our PSHE learning will be based around family and friendships. We will be exploring Christianity and what Chritians believe about God and Jesus in our Religion, Values and Beliefs lessons. During PE we will be practicing moving our bodies and different ways of moving out bodies and sending and receiving balls by rolling and throwing. Our computing topic focusses on the basics of using a computer and how technology can help us in everyday life.
