Create an imaginative story about the Stone Age using pictures to create a comic book style story.	Imagine you are an archaeologist and you have just discovered a chest from the Stone Age. What will be inside?	Design a costume for a Stone Age hunter for each season of the year.
If somebody from the Stone Age travelled to the present day- what would you show them and why? Where would you take them? What food would you introduce them to?	Can you make a fossil out of clay or playdough?	Design a piece of cave art using materials of your choice i.e. paint, chalk, crayon.
