General Reminders:

PE

This term our topic title is “Islamic Civilisation”

Happy New Year!

We hope you and your families enjoyed the Christmas Break and are looking forward to the new Spring term.

We are excited to introduce our new topic: Islamic Civilisation, which explores one of the most impactful periods in global history. We will look at the development of the great Islamic city of Baghdad including trading practices and everyday life and compare it with contemporary cities in Western Europe. We will learn about the spread of Islam through the Middle East and beyond and the legacy of and continuing influences of early Islam.

In English, the children will explore the text, “The Island” to write a narrative. They will also write a newspaper report. In our Guided Reading sessions the children will continue to develop their fluency and comprehension strategies through sharing and discussing a variety of texts.

In maths this term the children will be focusing on:

- Ratio
- Algebra
- Decimals

In art, the artist we will be focusing on is Samira Mian. We will investigate geometric patterns, and printing which will lead to making a Khatam clay coaster.

In computing we will be looking at using variables in computer programmes. We will look at how they are updated and experiment with changing them.

In Science, our topic is light. We will consolidate previous learning by exploring the way that light behaves, including light sources, reflection and shadows. We will make predictions and investigate the relationship between light sources, objects and shadows and understand how the eye works.

In RE our topic is ‘Is it better to express your religion in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?’. We will learn in depth from two different religions about why their holy buildings and works of art matter to them as expressions of devotion to God and worship, and about how.

In PSHE, our focus topics are Health and Well-Being. Within these topics the children will describe qualities or values they want to develop and create achievable goals, describe the importance of relaxation and suggest different strategies, looking at taking care of their physical wellbeing and understanding that technology can have an impact on physical and mental health.
