Summer 1 - How can we work together?

This term we will be looking at the question “How can we work together?” We will be exploring this around the stories of The Girl who Loves Bugs, Butterfly Bouquet and the Very Hungry Caterpillar.

We have lots of fun learning opportunities for the children to take part in this term:

Week 1 - We are welcoming new starters to our EYFS family and supporting them to understand classroom routines and expectations. Some tiny visitors will be arriving too!

Week 2 - We will be celebrating Earth Day and reflecting on how we can care for our environment.

Week 3 - We will explore seasonal change of summer and how we can stay safe in the sun.

Week 4 - We will be participating in FairTrade Week.

Week 5 - We will be exploring light / shadow.

Week 6 - We will reflect on the growth of our butterflies and record their life cycle. We will also celebrate our fantastic learning through the term with a Brilliant Bug Ball!

FS1

In maths we will be looking at number formations from 1—10. We will also be focusing on number recognition.

We will be reading the stories ‘The Girl who Loves Bugs’ and ‘The Very Hungry Caterpillar.’ During this term we will be applying narrative skills to support our understanding of the story.

FS2

The children will be using their phonics skills to support their independent reading and writing. They will practise reading and writing simple sentences using Fred Talk and Fred Fingers spelling. In mathematics they will be revisiting shape to explore concepts of rotation and composition. We will also be developing our control of balls, musical composition, understanding of place and teamwork.
