ENGLISH

This half term, our learning in English will be focused around Amazing Birds. We are looking at a range of exciting books which will enable our writing to include non-chronological report writing.

Reading will be taught daily during Guided Reading sessions which all children need to access now. Some children will have daily phonics intervention and reading too.

In Grammar, we will be looking at sentence writing and refining our understanding of what makes a sentence.



MATHS

This half term, we will continue with our learning on understanding the concept of division and how this relates to multiplication. We will also be learning about length and understanding metres and centimetres and using these to compare lengths of different things. We will also refine our knowledge of odd and even numbers.

Children should now know their 10x tables and be well on the way to know their 2x and 5x tables. They need to know both their multiplication and division facts.

HOMEWORK

This half term, a weekly Maths sheet will be sent home to complete again. This will be related to the basic skills which we practice daily in school. It will include number bonds to 20 which your child needs to know off by heart and 2x, 5x and 10x tables (including division facts). Homework will be given out each Thursday and needs returning for marking the following week.

Weekly spellings will be put in reading records. These are usually based on our Spelling scheme in school which is taught daily.

Reading – please read daily with your child. They must read their school reading book to you and then you can share a different story together too.
