

### **English Learning**

This half term we will be using the book 'The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe' in our English lessons. We will focus on writing and using superb sentence construction with expanded noun phrases and subordinate clauses. We will consolidate the use of punctuation and explore characters within classic fiction. We will aim to establish a reading culture within our classroom and hope that you will support with this at home, reading regularly with your child and exploring a range of reading texts.



### **Maths Learning**

Our focus in Maths will begin with place value which allows children to explore numbers up to the millions. In Year 5, these numbers can be tricky for the children to read so any practise at home will be valuable.
