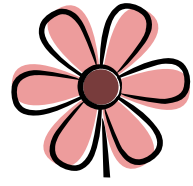

Maths

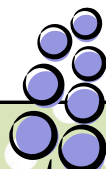
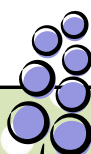
