English Learning

This half term we will be using the poem 'The Jabberwocky' by Lewis Carroll. This is an interesting poem which should create some imaginative work from the children.

We will focus on grammar, handwriting and spelling ready for Year 6.

You can help at home by making sure your child reads age appropriate texts each day at home for at least 10 minutes.

Maths Learning

Our focus in Maths will continue to focus on Shape, Space and Measures.

We will cover key learning such as Translation, reflection, symmetry, units of measurement, area and perimeter, volume and Roman Numerals.
