NON-NEGOTIABLES

These <u>have to be</u> completed on a weekly basis.

- Daily reading
- At least 10 minutes on Numbots.
- At least 10 minutes on Times Table Rock Stars.
- A daily phonics video, the links which are sent to you at the start of every half term.

Maths: Times Tables.

Make flashcards with the calculation on one side and the answer on the other.

Play games where you give the answer or the calculation. How many can your child win of you? Play at lest 10 minutes every night.

Science: Plants and Seed Dispersal

Collect a range of seeds and think about how the plant spreads their seeds. Create a poster showing different ways a plant spreads their seed and why it does this. Look closely at a dandelion to help you. Continue to plant seeds and watch them grow.

RE: Pentecost Party Costume.

Create a 'wind' costume for our Pentecost Party. We will be learning about why wind is a good symbol for the Holy Spirit. Our costumes will focus on the symbol of wind.

History Space travel.

Learn about Helen Sharman, Yuri Gagarin or Valentina Tereshkova. Who are they? What did they achieve? You can produce a poster or a book about them.







Math: Fractions and Time

Take pictures of finding halves and quarters of amounts at home. Share out sweets, fruit etc. Cut pizzas, toast, paper into halves and quarters.





Look at clocks constantly and get practising telling the time to the hour, half past, quarter past, quarter to and to 5 minutes. What time does your favourite programme start? Remember practice makes permanent!

Art: Sculpture.

We will be making sculptures of faces out of clay. You can make face sculptures out of playdough if you have it at home. You can also make face sculptures out of everyday objects.
