Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

We are excited to inform you that Year 3 will be taking part in a class trip to the World Museum in Liverpool to attend a *Discover Ancient Egypt* workshop and to explore the museum.

This is on Tuesday 28th April, and the coach will leave from school at 9am, so please can you drop your child off promptly on that day to ensure we have the necessary time to register them and do the pre-trip admin prior to getting on the coach. Please send your child in their school uniform with a coat if the weather is unsettled.

This visit will support our history learning and give the children a unique opportunity to explore ancient civilisations through real artefacts.

During the workshop, pupils will become *junior museum archaeologists*, handling genuine objects such as amulets and statuettes, and using them to uncover what life was like in Ancient Egypt over 3,000 years ago. Children will rotate through four activity stations focusing on:

- Egyptian gods and their symbols,
- Materials and artefact uses,
- Mummification, including examinations of animal mummies,
- Hieroglyphs and ancient writing, including looking at writing on mummy bandages.

We are very much looking forward to a fascinating day of hands-on history learning. If you have any questions, please feel free to get in touch.

Your child will need a packed lunch and drink in a named bag: please make sure everything in the bag is disposable. School can provide a packed lunch, however, due to legislation with Natasha's law, we do need up to date food allergy information. If this has changed since September, please contact the office as a matter of urgency. The order for a packed lunch will need to be in by Wednesday 1st April 2026. If no response is received by then, we will assume you will provide a lunch from home.

FLPS have kindly contributed towards the cost of coach; the cost of the workshop is £10.50 per child and a decreasing balance service on ParentPay will go live for this later this week, and it would be appreciated if this can be paid by Friday 24th April 2026.
