2026-27 Academic Year INSET Days – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please be advised that we have altered our INSET Days for the 2026-27 academic year. We are required by law to have 5 INSET days in each academic year.

September 2026

Wednesday 2nd September removed completely, so children now return on Wednesday 2nd and NOT Thursday 3rd September.

October 2026

Friday 2nd October removed completely, so children are now in school.

January 2027

Monday 4th January 2027, remains unchanged, so children return on Tuesday 5th January 2027.

July 2027

Friday 9th July removed completely, so children are now in school.

3 x new INSET days at the end of the academic year (Monday 19th, Tuesday 20th & Wednesday 21st July 2027).

This will mean that the school year ends on Friday 16th July 2027 for the children. This will hopefully assist with less expensive holiday costs for those wishing to book before the official start of the summer break.

If you have already booked holidays around the original published term & INSET dates, providing we receive proof that the holiday was booked prior to today's notification, (16th January 2026) we will acknowledge your booking and the absence will be authorised. For any bookings made after this announcement, absence will be unauthorised.

One of our external music providers, Create Music, are offering a free guitar taster session.

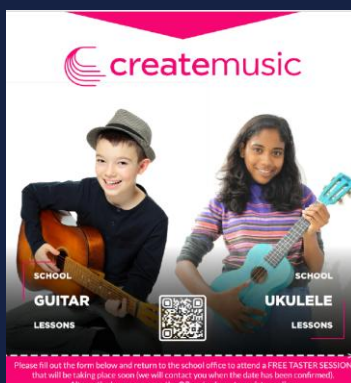

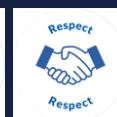
