Afternoon Collection – Playground Pickup

Year 4 Class Assembly & Classroom Visit – Thursday 29th January

Next week sees the first of our class assembly's and classroom visits of this academic year, starting with Year 4. This assembly will start straight after morning registration at approx. 9am. You will be able to enter school from 8.50am once the hall has been cleared by wraparound care and set up for the assembly. Please sign in and take a visitor sticker on arrival at the main entrance.

Following the assembly, parents are welcome to visit the classroom to see some of the children's latest work. We do ask that you depart school, via the main entrance, by approx 10/10.15am so the children can finish their morning session before break - thank you.

Please park at the rear & side of school. We do ask that you do not park on The Cobbles themselves or around the front of school. Please also do not block the playground gate at the rear, in case we require access for emergency vehicles – thank you.

2026-27 Academic Year INSET Days

A reminder that we have altered our INSET Days for the 2026-27 academic year.

Here is a summary of the changes made:

September 2026

Wednesday 2nd September removed completely, so children now return on Wednesday 2nd and NOT Thursday 3rd September.

October 2026

Friday 2nd October removed completely, so children are now in school.

January 2027

Monday 4th January 2027, remains unchanged, so children return on Tuesday 5th January 2027.

July 2027

Friday 9th July removed completely, so children are now in school.

3 x new INSET days at the end of the academic year (Monday 19th, Tuesday 20th & Wednesday 21st July 2027).

This will mean that the school year ends on Friday 16th July 2027 for the children. This will hopefully assist with less expensive holiday costs for those wishing to book before the official start of the summer break.

If you have already booked holidays around the original published term & INSET dates, providing we receive proof that the holiday was booked prior to last week's notification, (16th January 2026) we will acknowledge your booking and the absence will be authorised. For any bookings made after 16th January 2026, absence will be unauthorised.




Collective Worship



During Collective Worship, the children have held a class celebration "Who has tried hard to remain calm this week?
